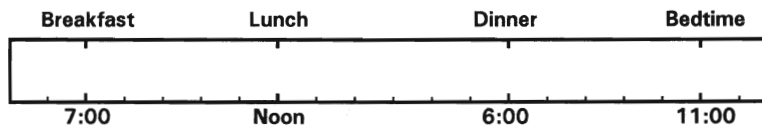

**Common uses**

This medication is typically used to reduce anxiety or to help induce sleep. It may also have other uses. Its effects can be felt within 1 hour.

How to use this medication

The dosage of this medication depends on what it is used for. Depending on the circumstance, it may be used regularly or only as needed. Follow the instructions provided by your doctor or pharmacist. This medication may be taken with or without food.

It is not advisable to stop using this product suddenly, particularly if you have been on it for several weeks. If you are considering stopping the medication, talk to your doctor or pharmacist first. Important: Follow the instructions on the label. Do not use more of this product, or more often, than prescribed.

As with most medications, this product should be stored at room temperature. Store it in a secure location where it will not be exposed to excessive heat, moisture or direct sunlight. Keep it out of reach of young children.

Possible side effects

In addition to its desired action, this medication may cause some side effects, notably:

- it may cause confusion;
- it may cause unusual tiredness;
- it may cause drowsiness that lasts until the next day -- use caution until you know how you will react;
- it can affect your balance;
- it may affect your memory.

Each person may react differently to a treatment. If you think this medication may be causing side effects (including those described here, or others), talk to your doctor or pharmacist.

Additional information

This medication may interact with another medication or supplement that you are taking. Although many interactions are minor, some may cause severe problems. Fortunately, many interactions may be dealt with by a dosage adjustment or a change in medication schedule. Check with your pharmacist before using this medication in combination with any other medications (including non-prescription products), vitamins or natural products.

This treatment may be habit-forming. Do not use this medication for longer than necessary. If you have difficulty stopping the medication when the treatment is finished, talk to your doctor or pharmacist.
