 - (a) The children of the marriage shall continue to remain in the matrimonial home, and the parents will provide care, on the following basis, commencing Monday, June 27, 1994:
 - WEEK 1 MONDAY: Husband shall pick up children from daycare and care for them until 9:00 p.m. in the home
 - TUESDAY: Wife shall pick up children from daycare and care for children

WEDNESDAY: as per Monday, to Husband
THURSDAY: as per Tuesday, to Wife
FRIDAY: as per Monday, to Husband
SATURDAY: Wife to care for children
SUNDAY: Wife to care for children


WEEK 2: MONDAY: Wife to pick children up from daycare and care for them
TUESDAY: Husband shall pick up children from daycare and care for them until 9:00 a.m. in the home
WEDNESDAY: as per Monday, to ~~Husband~~
THURSDAY: as per Tuesday, to Husband
FRIDAY: as per Monday, to Wife
SATURDAY: after children's swimming lessons ~~each Saturday~~ until Sunday at 9:00 p.m. the husband shall care for the children
SUNDAY: to alternate in consecutive weeks thereafter pending further Order of this Court.


- (b) In the interim, the wife shall reside in the matrimonial, except at the times that the Husband is to care for the children as set out above, until further Order of the
- (c) The Husband shall pay interim interim child support to the Wife, in the amount of \$700.00 per month, commencing July 1, 1994, until further Order of the Court.
- (d) ~~The~~ An assessment of the issue of custody shall be conducted by a qualified


professional, to be arranged and agreed upon by counsel!


- (e) Neither party shall communicate directly or indirectly to the other, except for matters to be discussed regarding the children.

- (g) The husband shall pay all mortgage, insurance, utility, and related expenses for the operation of the matrimonial home, Unit 1, 1077 Thomas Dolan Parkway, Dunrobin, Ontario, excluding the following payments, to be made by the wife: telephone* and household grocery expenses, until further Order of the Court.
- (h) The wife shall pay all daycare expenses until further Order of this Court!
